- E. No other gospel. Galatians 1:6-8

II. THE WAY OF SIN

- A. Rebellion and evil. Isaiah 1:2-4
- B. Separation from God. Isaiah 59:1-2
 - 1. God says, come back. Isaiah 55:6-7
- C. The way of death. Romans 6:23
 - 1. May seem right to man. Proverbs 16:25

III. STAYING OUTSIDE

- A. For Judah is was exile in Babylon. Jeremiah 6:22-23
- B. For us, destruction. Matthew 7:13-14
 - 1. Flaming fire. 2 Thessalonians 1:8-9

IV. COMING INSIDE

- A. Forgiveness in Christ. Ephesians 1:7
- B. Hope of heaven. I Peter 1:3-4
- C. A crown of righteousness. 2 Timothy 4:6-8
